Attend school regularly and be on time to school and lessons.	Ensure my child is punctual to the start of the day and attends regularly. Contact the school regarding absence or attendance issues.	Make contact with you regarding concerns about attendance and punctuality.
Have all the correct equipment / books / clothing for lessons.	Ensure that my child has the correct equipment for school.	Provide a stimulating learning environment.
Be a positive member of my House group.	Encourage my child to be a positive member of their House group.	Give pupils the opportunity to make his/her own decisions in a safe and supportive environment.
Be polite and helpful towards other pupils and adults.	Attend parents' evenings during the academic year and respond to reports where appropriate.	Welcome you for both formal and informal discussions regarding your child's progress.
Wear school uniform in the manner outlined by the school.	Follow the school uniform code and seek advice where necessary.	Provide a uniform update annually; endeavour to make it practical and affordable. Monitor and respond to standards of uniform.
