
This leaflet shows the ten minute walking zone that has been mapped out by our pupils.

In order to reduce congestion at the school gate we would like people who currently arrive by car to try parking around the edge of the walking zone and walk the rest of the way to school.



This will improve safety and the environment around the school site for everyone and allow the opportunity for some healthy exercise at the start and end of the school day.

Pupils from the school mapped and walked the routes to measure how far you can get in 10 minutes.

If you live inside the walking zones you could walk or cycle to and from school every day. Even if you need the car to travel to work, it may be quicker and easier to leave it parked at home while you walk to school.

If you live just outside the zone, try walking or cycling - it could be quicker than you think!

If you have to travel by car to school, please try to park around the edge of the walking zone, with care and consideration for local residents, and walk the rest of the way.












Our aims:
