- **Coach has a toilet on board, DVD player and comfy seats**



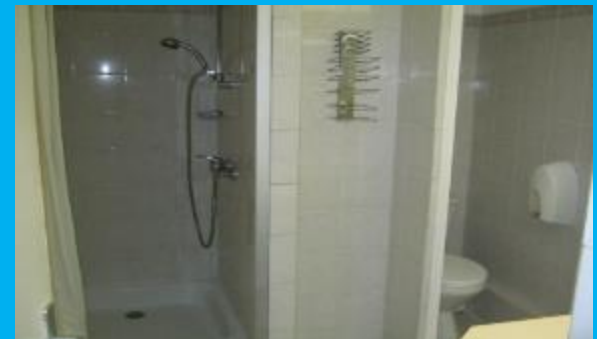
Accommodation and facilities

Key Information

- **Accompanied by ratio of adults**
- **PUPIL ACCOMMODATION**
- **Close to departure pupils will be asked to choose a friend to share a room with**
- **Pupils will be told their rooms on arrival**
- **STAFF ACCOMMODATION**
- **Staff will be in rooms located in the middle and ends of corridors**
- **All pupils will need a passport and in date EHIC card or new GHIC card.**

- Special diets catered for by prior arrangement

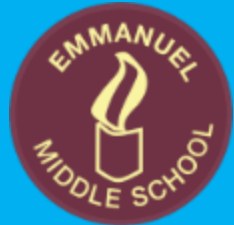
